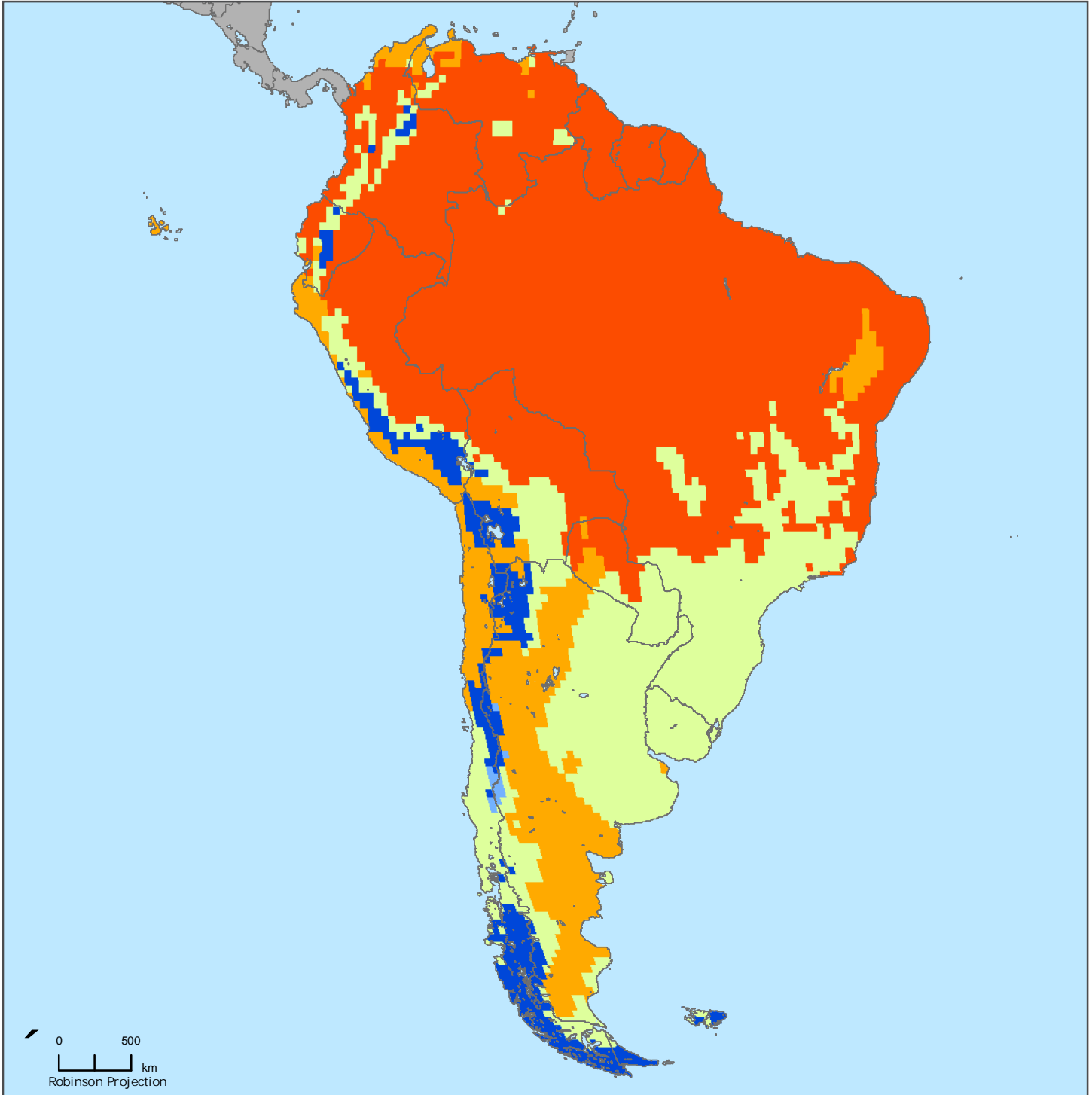


Climate Zones
