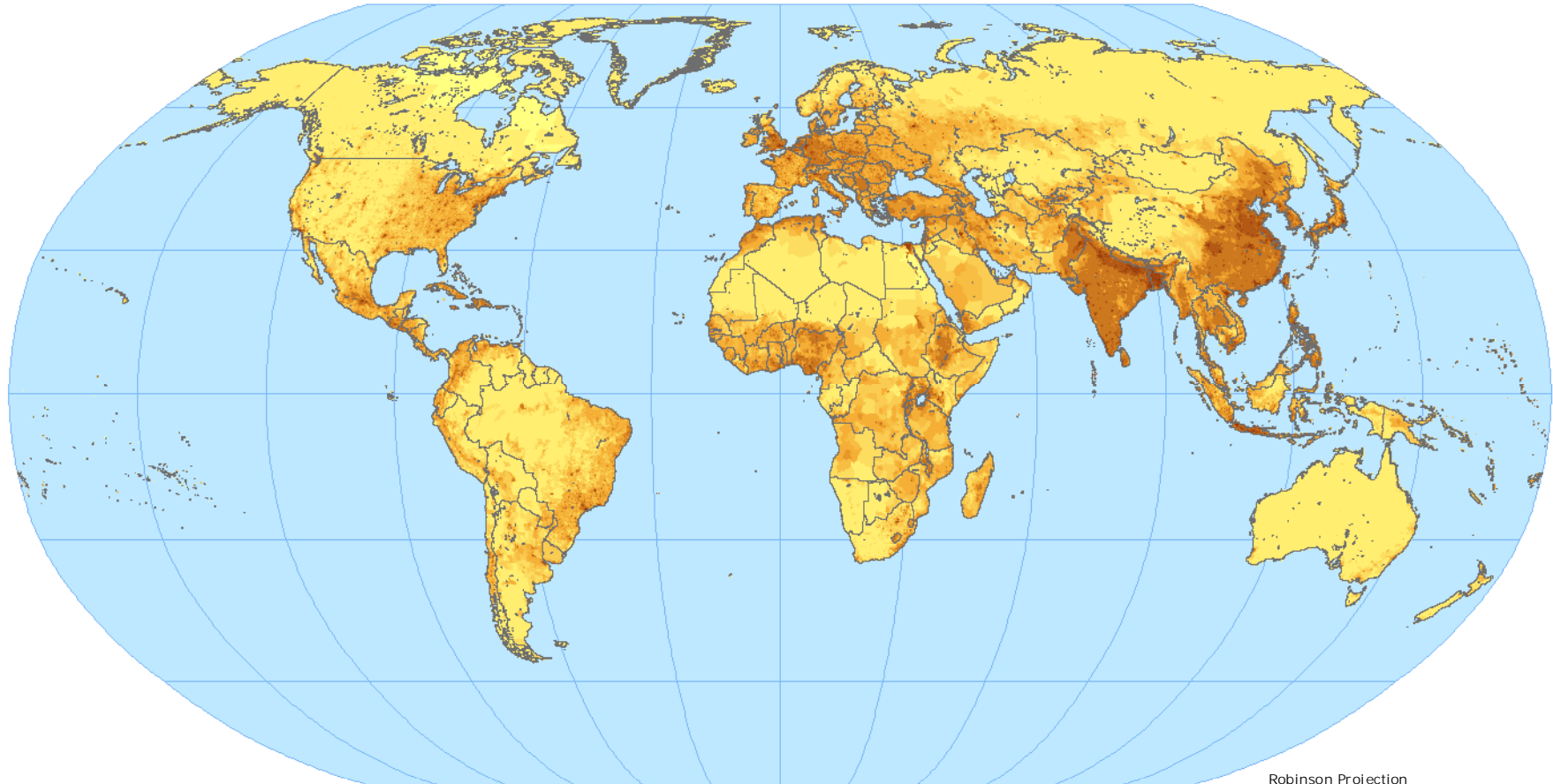


# Population Density

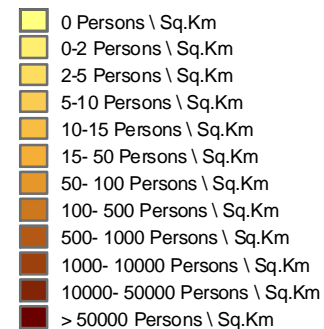

Population Density layers, (persons per square kilometer) for 1990 and 2000 were created by dividing the 1990 and 2000 UN-adjusted population (POP) count grids by the land area (LA) grid (circa 2000).
